

**TOWN OF ROME, MAINE
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
JUNE 24, 2019
MINUTES**

Chairman Paul Anderson called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 6:00 pm in the Selectmen's Office at the Rome Community Center in Rome. Selectmen Anderson, Stratton and Archer were present. A quorum was declared. Also present for all or parts of the meeting was Tammy Lyons, Ed Pearl Jr., Carroll Bubar, Andrew Cook, Dennis Phillips.

Recitation of Pledge of Allegiance.

Stratton/Archer Motion to accept minutes from June 10, 2019 selectman meeting.
Anderson, Stratton, Archer in favor (3-0)

Dennis Phillips spoke to the board and asked that some consideration be made for Larry DiPietro Sr. regarding the pending court case.

Ed Pearl spoke to the board about using the Forestry Grant that the Fire Dept. was awarded. They will be reimbursed at 50% for new equipment.

Carroll Bubar, Road Commissioner, provided information to the board about repairing Wooster Hill Rd and Mercer Rd. He has a 2 year plan that would end with both roads being completed. He will bring in a more detailed quote.

Paul Anderson informed the board that the RSU #18 budget came in roughly \$8,000 under budget.

Andrew Cook presented his suggestions regarding the Town and First Park. He highly recommends that the town leaves First Park as soon as it becomes possible. The board agrees that a warrant article should be put in for next year and that the Town will be able to vote on the matter.

Tammy Lyons presented the payroll to the board.
